- 26 Aug 1881 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book Death Record; number 12  
Louisa Noerenberg (nee Ziemer), wife of Michael Noerenberg of Elisabethpol
- 16 Dec 1884 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book Baptism Record, number 52  
Louise Nürnberg; daughter of Mich. Nürnberg of Elisabethpol and wife Louis\_ (nee Schröder)
- 18 Feb 1885 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book Death Record, number 179  
Louisa Nöhrenberg,  
daughter of Michael Nöhrenberg and wife Louisa nee Schröder, in Elisabethpol
- 16 May 1886 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book, Confirmation , page 261, line 642  
Anna Christina Nerrenberg Confirmation,  
daughter of Michael Nerrenberg and Louisa Ziemer  
[listed directly above Anna is Juliana Riechert]
- 11 Dec 1889 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book Baptism Record, number 43  
Konstantin Nörenberg son of Michael Nörenberg and wife Louise (nee Schröder)  
need to see top of page for column headings
- 21 Jun 1895 Elisabethpol Evangelical Church Book Death Record, number 9  
Michael Nörenberg; wife = Louise born Schröder  
age 54 years, 9 months  
birthplace: Katavis\_now \_\_\_ Brezin
- 21 Jul 1904 Confirmation Certificate; Elisabethpol, Wladimir-Wolnynnia, Russia  
(original belonged to Donald Norenberg. Karrie Blees has a copy)  
Konstantin Nörenberg
- 1909 Jan 9: Hamburg Passenger List (written in German. US manifest after arrival in NY spelled same)  
Konstantin Nirenberg
- 1911 Feb 25 Marriage Certificate (written by Justice of the Peace)  
Constantin Murenberg and Barta Arnt
- 1921 Nov 8 Declaration of Intent (US Naturalization)  
Constantin Norenberg (his signature)
- 1939 May 31 Declaration of Intent (US Naturalization)  
Constantin Norenberg (his signature)
- 1943 United States Naturalization  
name changed to  
Constantin Norenberg [from Konstantin Nurenberg] – no umlaut on American typewriter
