Homestead Certificate No. *1497*

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at *New Ulm, Minnesota*, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *August Dittrich*

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the east half of the north west quarter of Section thirty four, in Township one hundred and eight, of Range one, in the district of lands subject to sale at New Ulm, Minnesota containing eighty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *August Dittrich* the tract of Land above described: To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *August Dittrich* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, *Olyses S. Grant*, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
